2. At this stage of the hearing of the writ petition, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that it would suffice, if the first respondent is directed to dispose of

the revision petition filed by the petitioner, dated 09.07.2014, on merits and in accordance with law, within a specified period.
