PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India praying to issue Writ of mandamus to direct the respondents to consider and take appropriate action on the petitioner's representations dated 21.07.2014 and 11.08.2014 thereby direct them to make entry of the petitioner Punja land comprised in Survey No.288/11, to an extent of 40.5 Ares situated at Koodapattu Revenue Village, Thirupattur Taluk, Vellore District, as Joint Pattadharar of Patt land No.1101 in the Revenue/settlement/land register, which has been maintained by the fourth respondent, namely, the Tahsildar, Thirupattur Taluk, Vellore District.

The petitioner is directed to give a copy of the said representations including the order passed by this Court within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. With this direction, the writ petition stands disposed of. No Costs.

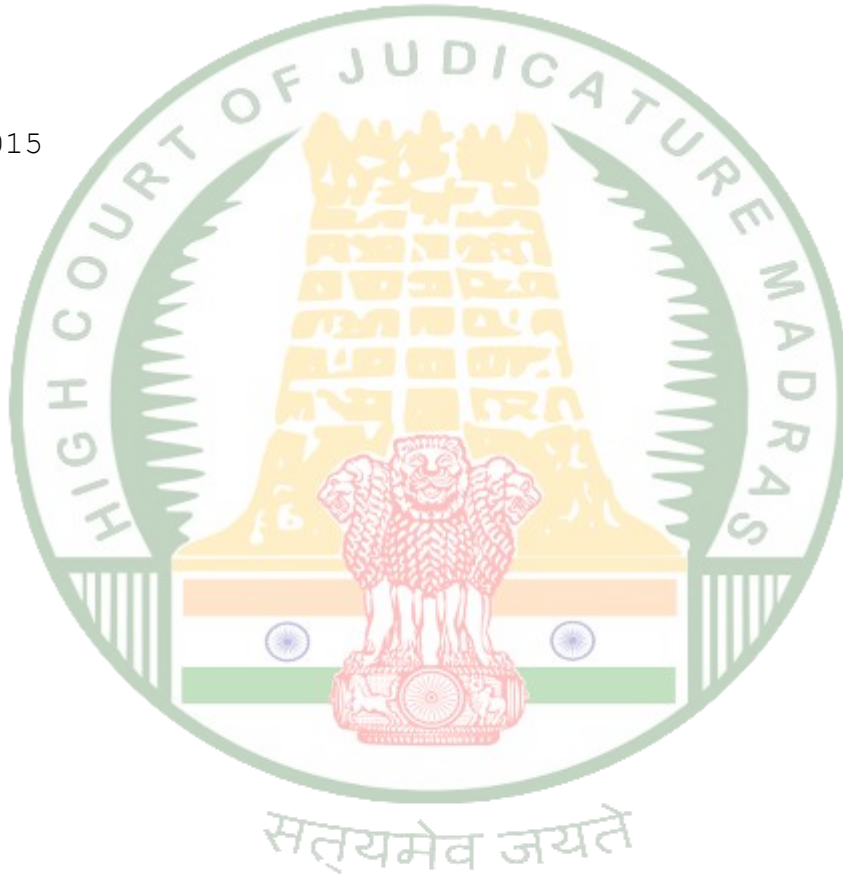
