In view of the order passed in W.P.No.27016 of 2015 (M.Anbazhagan v. Government of Tamil Nadu, rep. by Secretary to Government, Home (Police IV) Department, Secretariat, Chennai-600 009 and others) dated 03.11.2015 and there being some element of ambiguity on the issue of translation, it is agreed that the petitioner would be entitled to the benefit of one mark and thus, would reach the bench mark. The petitioner is thus entitled to the declaration of his result on merit.

2. The writ petition is accordingly allowed, leaving the parties to bear their own costs.

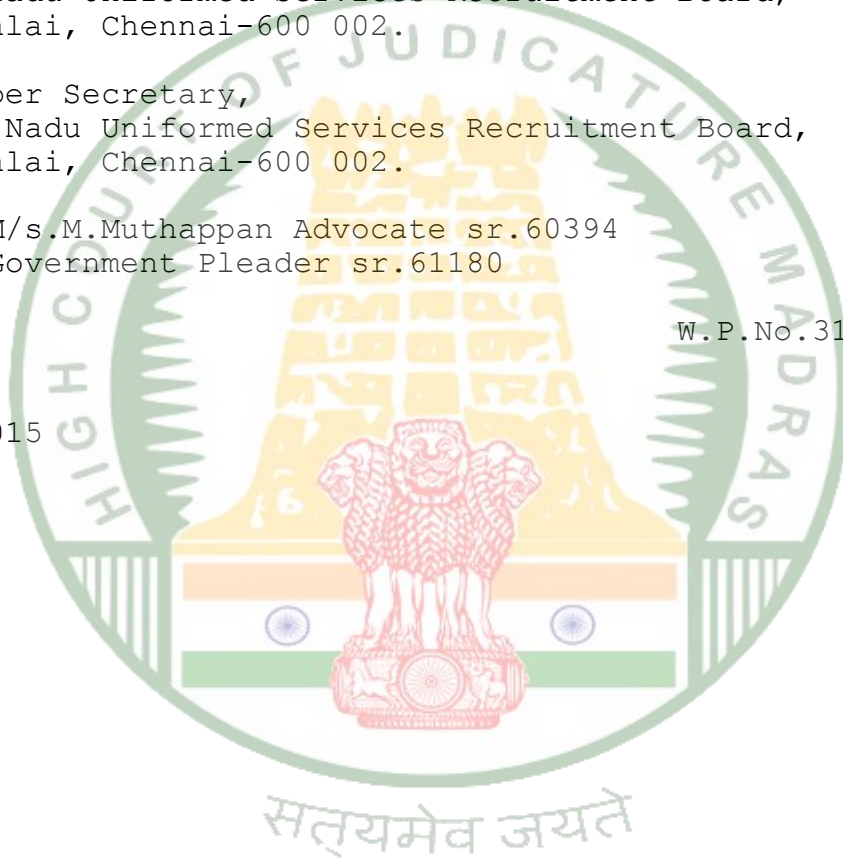
