Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking for direction upon the learned District and Sessions Court (PCR Court) Perambalur, to consider the petitioners' bail Petition in Cr.No.60 of 2015, on the file of the respondent for offence under Sections 294(b), 324 and 506 (i) IPC read with Section 3 (i) (r) and (s) and 3 (2) (v) (a) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Ordinance Act, 2014.

O R D E R

The petitioners seek for direction upon the learned District and Sessions Judge (PCR) Perambalur, to consider their bail applications on the same day in the event of their surrender in connection with a case in Crime No.60 of 2015, on the file of the respondent/Police.

2. The petitioners are accused for offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 324 and 506 (i) IPC read with Section 3 (i) (r) and (s) and 3 (2) (v) (a) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Ordinance Act, 2014.

3. The submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor, representing the respondent were heard. The materials available on record were also perused.

4. Considering the nature of offences alleged against the petitioners, the fact that anticipatory bail cannot be granted in respect of offences punishable under the Scheduled Castes and

Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Ordinance Act, 2014, and that taking into custody of the petitioners, pending consideration of their bail application could cause them irreparable hardship, this Court considers it appropriate to direct the learned District and Sessions Judge (PCR Court) Perambalur, to consider the bail applications of the petitioners on merits and pass appropriate order on the same day of their surrender.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition is ordered.
