2. The submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor, representing the respondent were heard.

3. It is seen that the petitioner has given complaint to the Superintendent of Police and Deputy Superintendent of Police, who are the first and second respondents respectively. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition is closed with liberty to the petitioner to go in person and lodge his complaint before the Station House Officer. On receipt of the such complaint, the Station House Officer is directed to investigate into the matter and register a

crime, if cognizable offence is made out, by following the dictum laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Lalita Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P. & others reported in [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)].
