PRAYER : Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure praying to direct the Principal District Judge, Chengalpattu, to consider the bail petition of the petitioners on the very same day in the event of surrender by the petitioners before the Principal Sessions Judge, Chengalpattu in Crime No.91 of 2015 on the file of the Inspector of Police, Sadras Police Station, Kanchipuram District.

O R D E R

The petitioners seek for a direction to the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Chengalpattu, to consider their bail applications on the same day in the event of their surrender in connection with a case in Crime No.91 of 2015, on the file of the respondent/Police.

2. The petitioners are accused for offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 324, 307 IPC read with Section 3(1) (x) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Ordinance Act, 2014.

3.The submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor, representing the respondent were heard. The materials available on record were also perused.

4.Considering the nature of offences alleged against the petitioners, the fact that anticipatory bail cannot be granted in respect of offences punishable under the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Ordinance Act, 2014, and that taking into custody of the petitioners, pending consideration of their bail application could cause them irreparable hardship, this Court considers it appropriate to direct the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Chengalpattu, to consider bail applications of the petitioners on merits and pass appropriate order on the same day of their surrender. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition is ordered.
