3. it is represented by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent that this petitioner has given a complaint against his brother Thangavelu and his brother also has given a complaint against this petitioner. Hence, the petition enquiry is pending against the petitioner.

4. In my considered opinion, no blanket direction as prayed for by the petitioner can be given. If the petitioner is wanted either for enquiry or for interrogation, he can very well be summoned by the respondent police and while doing so, the petitioner shall not be harassed. At the same time, the petitioner should submit himself to the respondent for interrogation and enquiry.

5. With the above observation, the Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
