bound to register a case, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of, by directing the second respondent police to register the case on the basis of the petitioner's complaint, dated 11.09.2014, and investigate the same in accordance with law.

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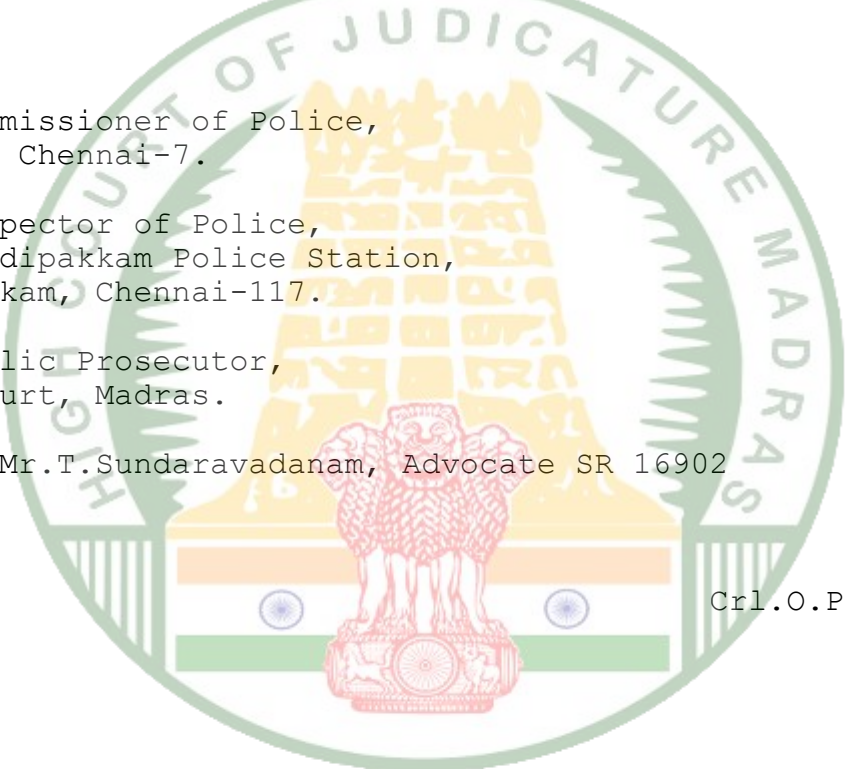
