PRAYER : This petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider and pass appropriate orders on the representation dated 19.10.2015 either to allot the land comprised in survey Nos. 723/6, 723/7, 723/8, 723/22 and 723/24 measuring an extent of 11572 Sq.Feet at Vyarsarpadi, Chennai, on free of cost or on the applicable cost to the same to the petitioner institution.

ORDER

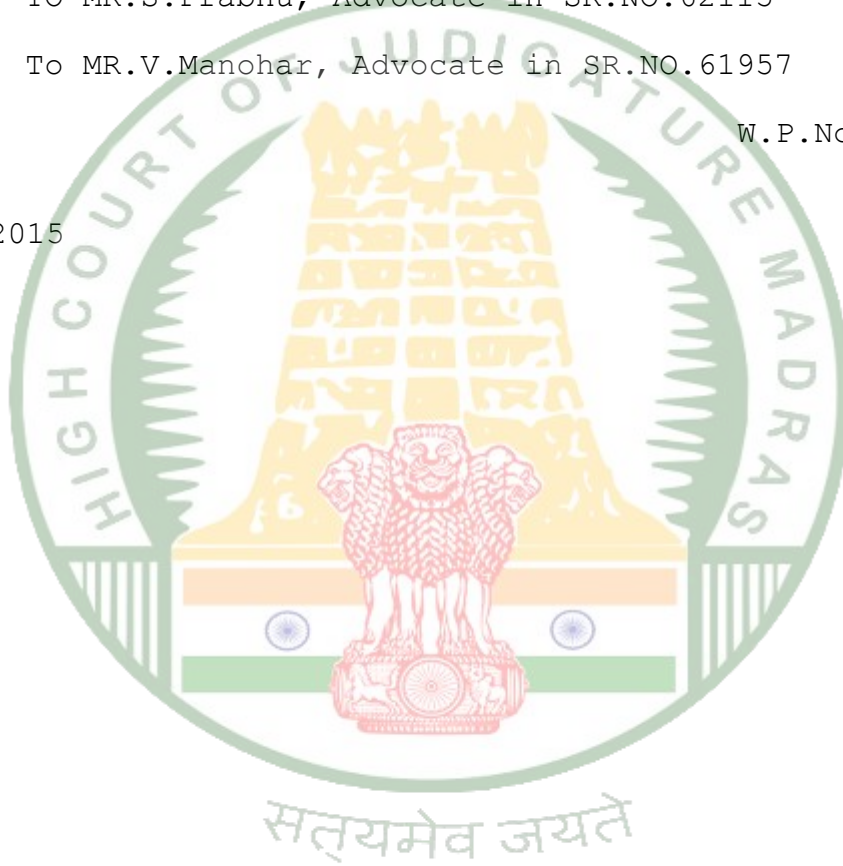
