3. It is seen that one Shanmugam had lodged a complaint against this petitioner and during the course of enquiry, both of them had agreed to pursue the remedies before the Civil Court. Thereafter, this petitioner has filed another complaint against the Shanmugam with the same set of facts.

4. Under such circumstances, no positive directions can be issued for registering the FIR, which does not disclose cognizable offence and therefore, this petition is closed, with a liberty to the petitioner to workout his remedy, in the manner known to law.

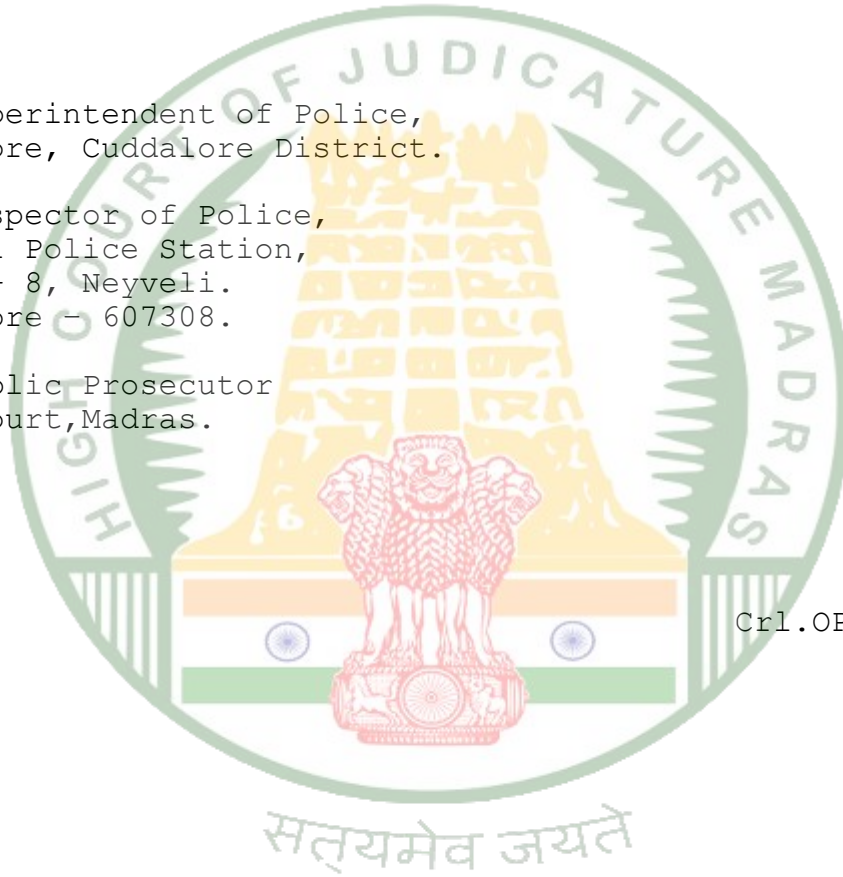
