ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.R.Lakshmi Narayanan, learned Additional Government Pleader accepting notice for the respondents 1 and 2 and with their consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

2 The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking for issuance of a writ of mandamus to direct the 1st respondent to dispose of the petitioner's application wherein he has prayed for enhancement of compensation awarded by the 2nd respondent for the lands which are acquired from the petitioner.

3 It is seen that pursuant to the application filed by the petitioner, the 1st respondent has issued a notice to the petitioner on 13.04.2015 and in response to the said notice, the petitioner has also submitted his written objections on 16.04.2015 which has been sent by speed post.

4 Learned Additional Government Pleader appearing on behalf of the respondents, submitted that reasonable time may be granted to the 1st respondent to finalise the matter.

5 In the light of the above, there will be a direction to the 1st respondent to take note of the objections given by the petitioner and pass final orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6 The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.

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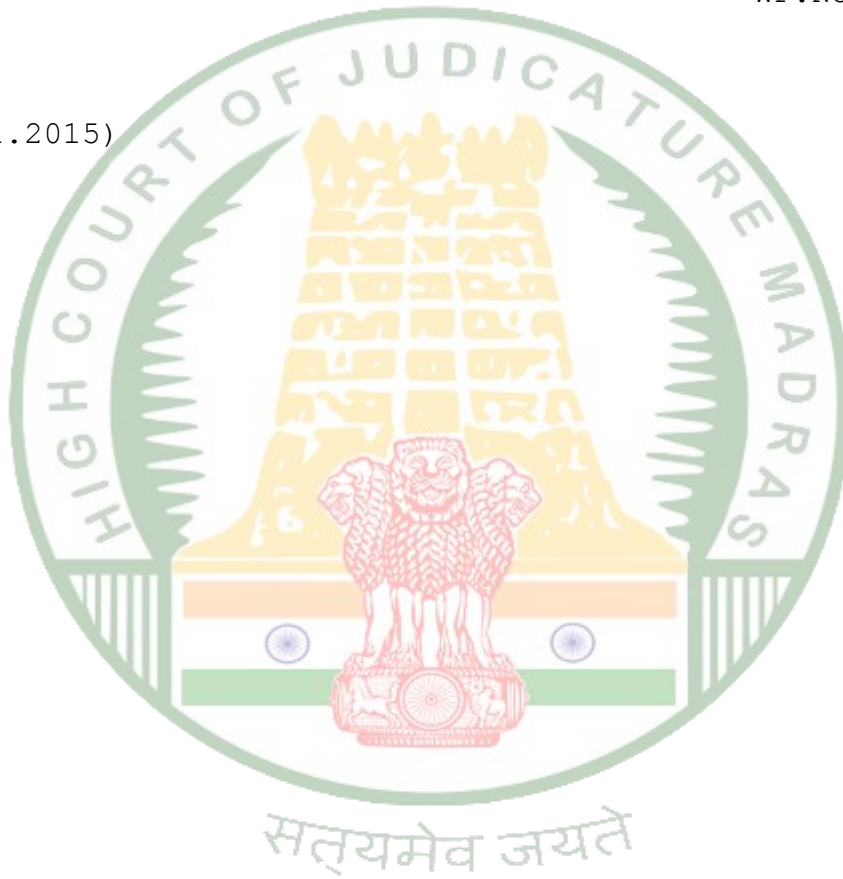
