4. The petitioner, has submitted a representation, on 2/10/2015, to the third respondent, claiming compensation for the land, utilising the petitioner's land by taking over the same under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Acquisition of Land for Industrial Purposes Act, 1997.

5. The aforesated representation has been received by the respondents as could be seen from the copies of the postal acknowledgement card filed in the typed set of papers.

6. The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents submitted that a reasonable time may be granted to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 2/10/2015.

In the light of the above, the third respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 2/10/2015 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording personal hearing to the petitioner, within a period of three months, from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
