ORDER

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor, representing the respondent/Police submitted that the petition enquiry is pending on the file of the second respondent/Police and the Additional Public Prosecutor pressed that the petitioner may be directed to co-operate with the second respondent/Police for conducting investigation.

In view of the above submission, this Criminal Original Petition is closed with direction to the petitioner to co-operate with the investigation and produce all necessary records to the second respondent/Police. During the course of investigation, if the complaint given by the petitioner discloses any cognizable

offence, the second respondent shall take further action in accordance with law, by registering the case, in the light of the dictum laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in re Lalita Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P. & others reported in [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)].

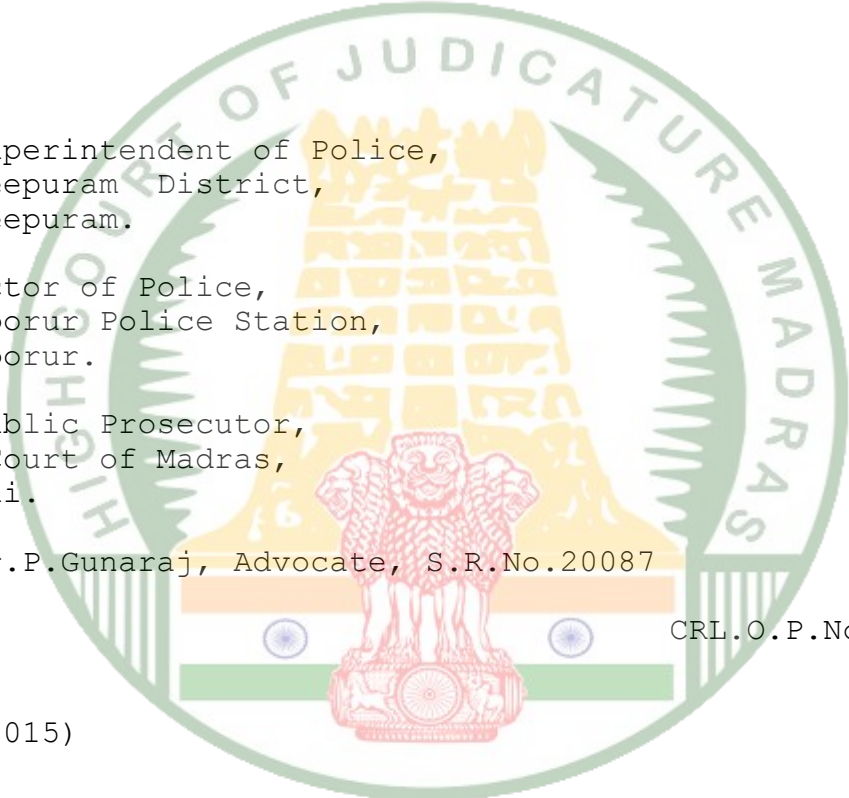
