ORDER

Seeking a direction to the respondent police not to harass the petitioners under the guise of an enquiry except in a manner known to law, the petitioner has come up with this petition.

2. This petition has come up today for admission. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent and I have also perused the records carefully.

3. In my considered opinion, no blanket direction as prayed for by the petitioners could be given. If the petitioners are wanted either for enquiry or for interrogation, they can very well be summoned by the respondent police and while doing so, the petitioners shall not be harassed. At the same time, the petitioners should submit themselves to the respondent for interrogation and enquiry. It is made clear that this order will not be shield against arrest if the petitioners are involved in cognizable offence.

4. With the above observation, the Criminal Original Petition is closed.

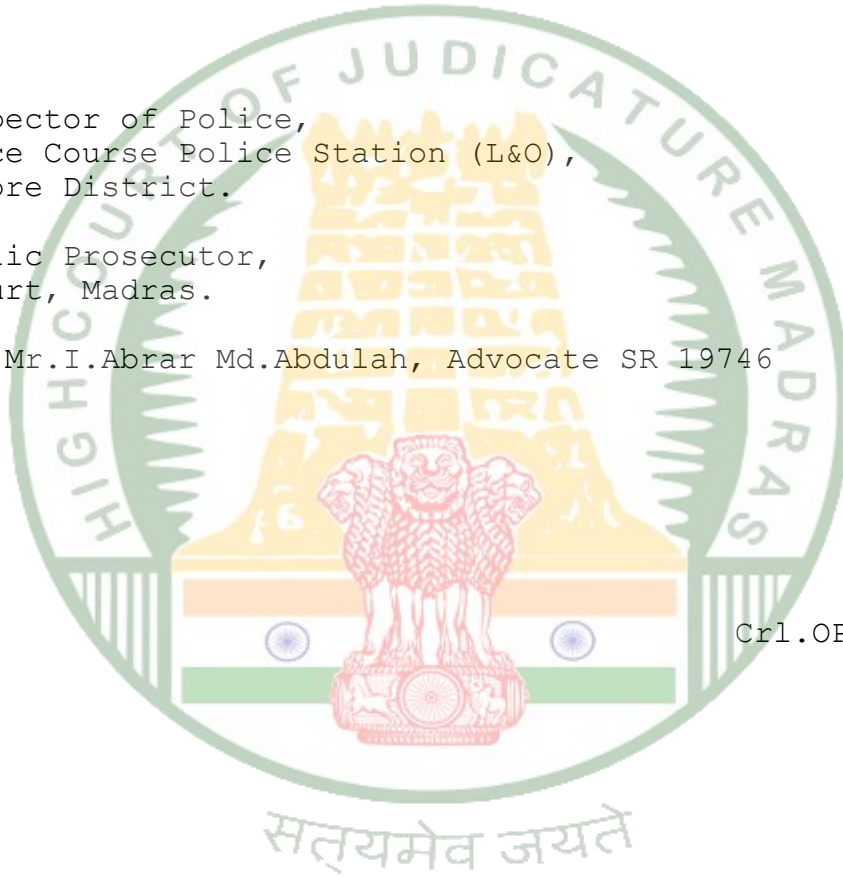
