3.On reading of the complaint, it appears that the matter is essentially a money dispute between petitioner and the opposite party. In order to give criminal colour, the petitioner has given the complaint as if the proposed party has assaulted him. Under such circumstances, this Court is of the considered opinion that no positive direction would be issued to the petitioner. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition is closed with liberty to the petitioner to work out his remedies in the manner known to law.
