ORDER

This writ petition came on transfer from the Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal.

The petitioner approached the then Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal seeking to quash the impugned proceedings issued by the second respondent dated 18.07.2002, to direct the second respondent to include the name of the petitioner in the appropriate place in the panel of Grade I Warders fit for promotion as Chief Head Warder of the year 2001-2002 communicated in proceedings No.23015/ES3/2002 dated 27.06.2002 in the Prison Department and to direct the second respondent to appoint the petitioner as Chief Head Warder retrospectively.

3. When the matter was listed on the last occasion on 13.03.2015, no one appeared for the petitioner. Therefore, this Court, in an effort to give one more opportunity, directed the registry to list the matter under the caption "For Dismissal". Even today, there is no representation for the petitioner. Hence, the writ petition is dismissed for default. No costs.
