Considering the above submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and taking into account, the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, the writ petition stands disposed of with a direction to the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue with the possession of the property situated in Town Survey No. 2725/1 & 2, Kancheepuram Town, Kancheepuram District, for a further period of three months, from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. 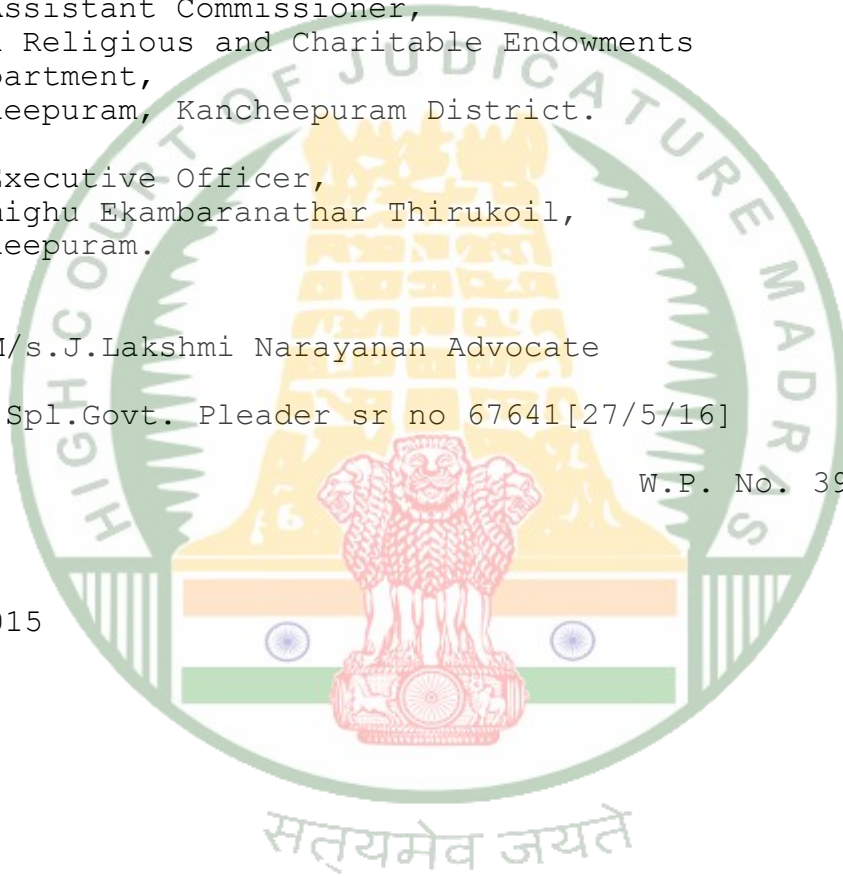
