Prayer: The Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to grant special time scale of pay of Rs.1300-3000+Grade Pay of Rs.300/- with effect from 15.09.2010 as per G.O.Ms. No.385, Finance (Pay Cell) Department dated 01.10.2010 with all consequential service and monetary benefits.

O R D E R

By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2. The case of the petitioners is that they were appointed as part - time Sweeper on consolidated pay and they are working in the post for more than 10 years. As per G.O.Ms.No.385, Finance (Paycell) Department on 01.10.2010, the employees who have been completed three years of service were granted special time scale of pay of Rs.1300-3000+ Grade pay of Rs.300/-.

3. The petitioners would further state that similarly placed employees filed writ petitions in W.P.Nos.9556 and 9557 of 2012 and based on the order of this Court, they were extended the benefit under the G.O. Since the same benefit was not given to the petitioners, they made a representation dated 10.10.2015 and it was not considered favourably. Therefore, the present writ petition has been filed.

4. Mr.M.Purushothaman, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that pursuant to the order passed in W.P.Nos.26710 to 26712 of 2013 in similar matters, the government has issued an order extending the benefit on 30.09.2015 vide proceedings Na.Ka.No.4486/A/2015.

5. Heard Mr.M.Purushothaman, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and Mr.V.Jayaprakash Narayanan, learned Special Government Pleader, who accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Though the petitioner prayed for a larger relief, this Court, considering the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the case, directs the third respondent to consider and dispose of the representation of the petitioners dated 10.10.2015 on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of ten weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner.

With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.

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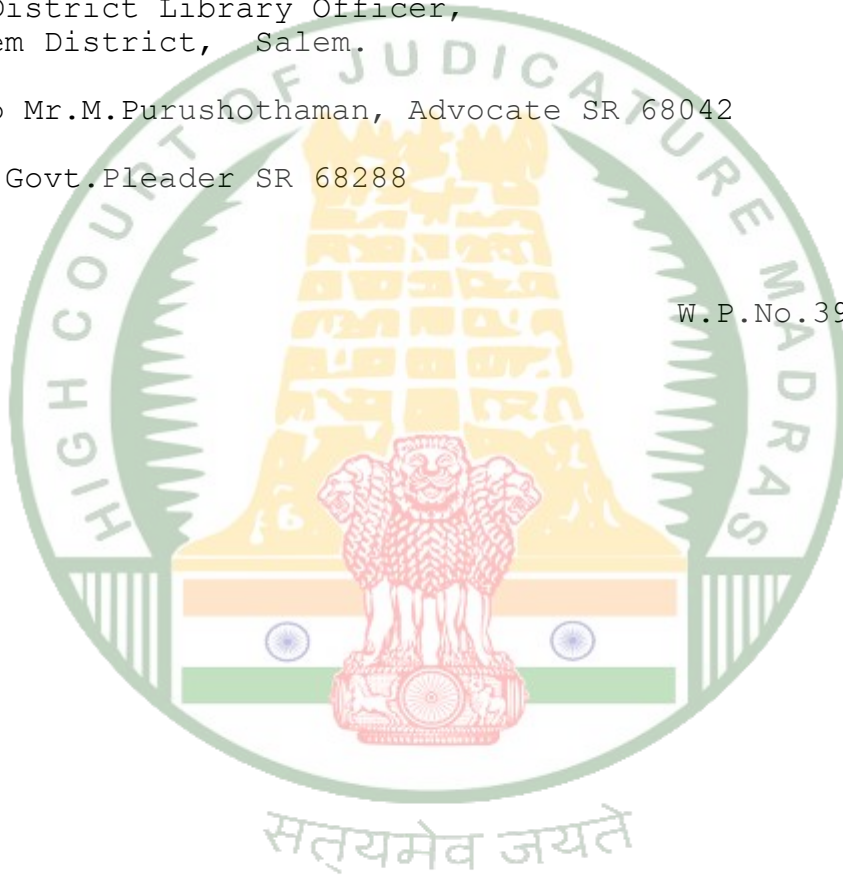
