It is made clear that in case the respondent is placing reliance on documents, all such documents should be given to the petitioner.

3. The writ petition is disposed of with the above direction.

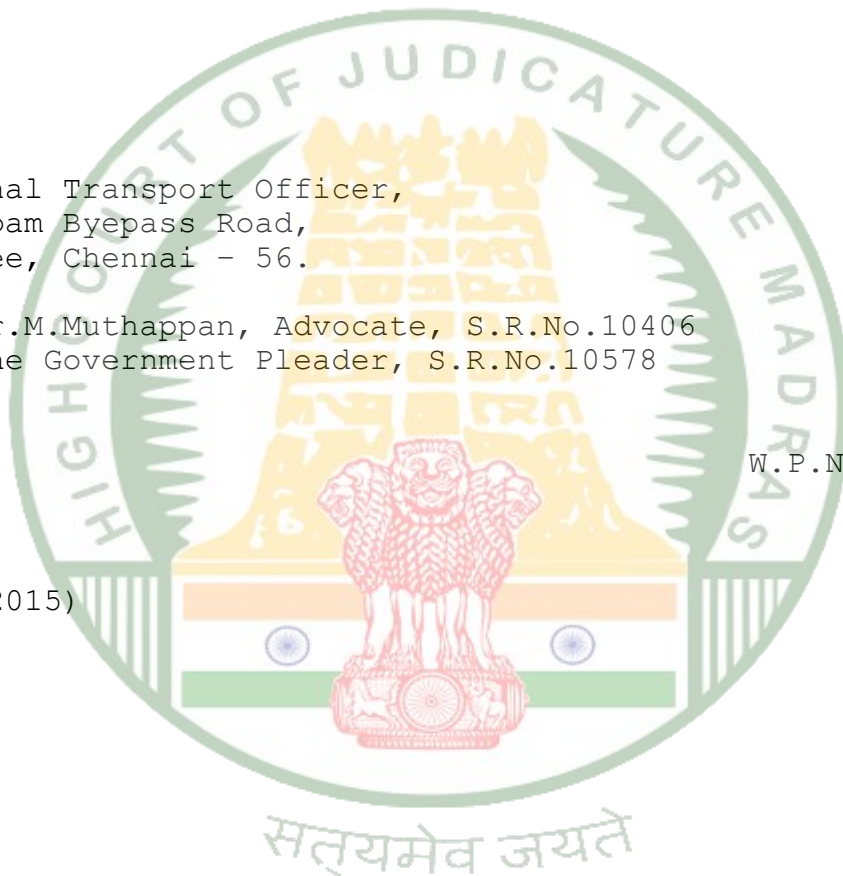
