ORDER

Heard Mr.A.Selvendran, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr.R.V.Babu, learned counsel who accepts notice for the respondents and with their consent, the writ petition is disposed of at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner seeks for a writ of mandamus to direct the respondents to issue the plot allotment order in respect of their house sites situated in S.No.866/9 part at New Anna Nagar, Thanthai Periyar Nagar and Annai Sathya Nagar in Thirumullaivoyal village, on receipt of the necessary fees under the Tamil Nadu Urban Development Project.

3.On taking notice, learned counsel appearing for the respondents submitted that no individual representations were submitted by the petitioners and no proof of part payment has also been enclosed.

4.Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners will submit their individual representations along with the proof of part payment.

5.In such circumstances, this writ petition is disposed of, granting liberty to the petitioners to submit their representations individually along with the proof of part payment, before the 1st respondent, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on receipt of the said representations, the 1st respondent shall consider the claim of the petitioners. On merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the said representations. No costs.
