The petitioner is an employee of Tamil Nadu State Marketing Corporation Limited (hereinafter referred to as "TASMAC"). 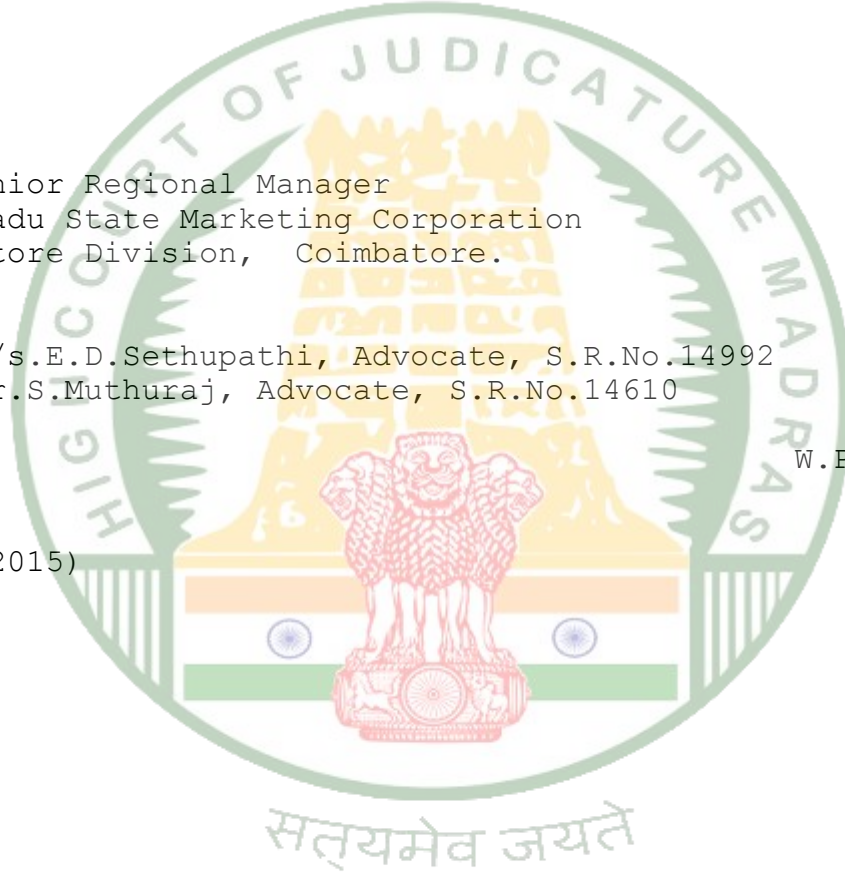
