Such exercise shall be completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The petitioner is permitted to forward a copy of the representation dated 03.10.2012 along with a copy of this order so as to enable the 2nd respondent to pass appropriate orders as expeditiously as possible.

The writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs. Connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

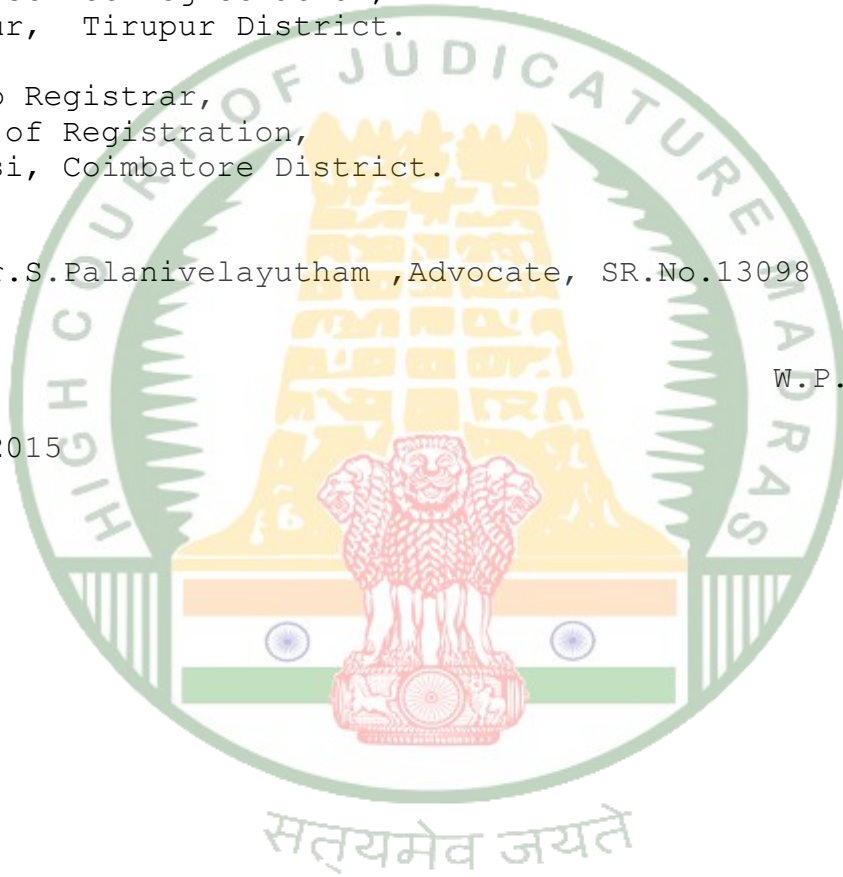
