Heard the learned counsels appearing on behalf of the parties concerned. No representation for the second and the third respondents.

At this stage of the hearing of the Writ Petition, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner had submitted that it would suffice, if a direction is issued to the first respondent to pass orders on the representation of the petitioner, dated 23.7.2012, on merits and in accordance with law, within a time frame specified by this Court. The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing on behalf of the first respondent has no objection for this court passing such an order.

3. In such circumstances, this Court finds it appropriate to direct the first respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 23.7.2012, if it is otherwise in order, and dispose of the same, on merits and in accordance with law, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, the second and the third respondents and the other persons concerned, if any, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The petitioner shall furnish a copy of the representation, dated 23.7.2012, to the first respondent, along with a copy of this order. However, it is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter. The Writ Petition is disposed of, with the above directions. No costs.
