2.The controversy in question is of enforcement of a bond of Rs.20,000/- and one does not know whether the appellant is there and has any interest in prosecuting the same, that too after scrutiny at two levels in the original suit of 1983.

3.We, thus, see no reason to spend time on this appeal and close the same with liberty to the learned counsel to revive the

same if the appellant shows any interest.

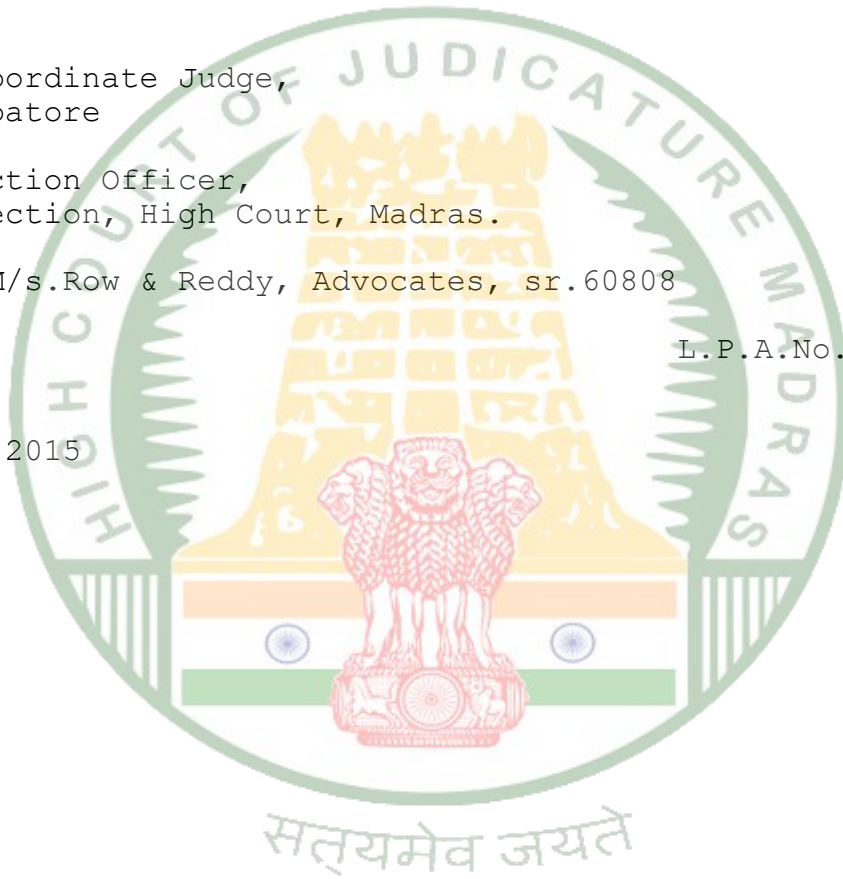
