3. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent has no objection for such an order being passed by this Court.

In view of the submissions made by the learned counsels appearing on behalf of the parties concerned, the respondent is directed to pass orders on the application made by the petitioner, dated 7.12.2012, if it is otherwise in order, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, as well as the other persons concerned, if any. The petitioner is directed to furnish a copy of the application, dated 7.12.2012, to the

respondent, along with a copy of this order. However, it is made clear that this Court, by this order, has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter.

5. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of, with the above directions. No costs.

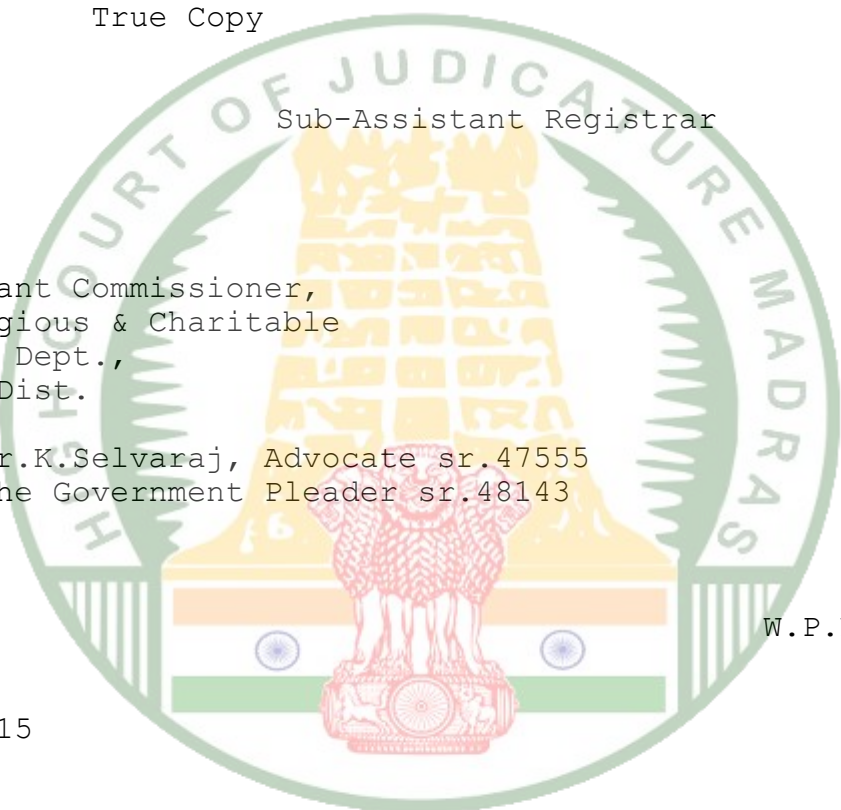
