ORDER

The petitioners approached the Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal, Chennai in O.A.No.817 of 2004 challenging the order passed by the first respondent and to consequently promote them as Senior Analyst according to their seniority. When the matter was taken up, both the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Government Pleader for the respondents submitted that the prayer has become infructuous, since the petitioners have already been promoted as Senior Analysts vide G.O.(Ms.) No.231, Health and Family Welfare (M1) Department dated 20.7.2012.

3. Recording the above statement, this writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

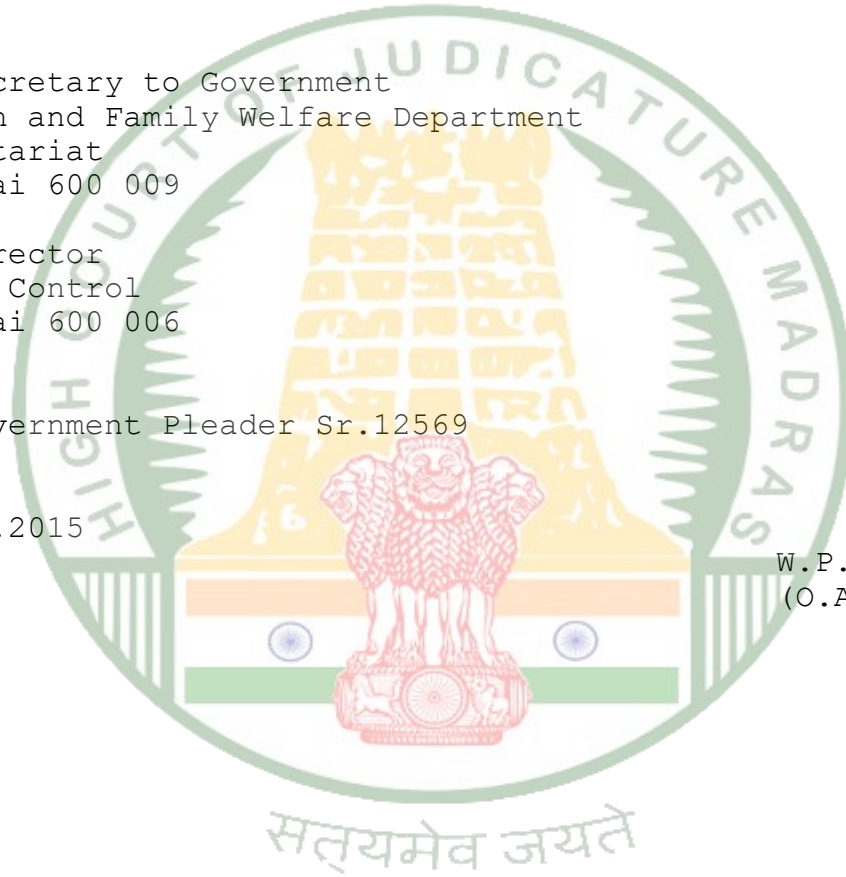
