Petition in W.P.No.42989 of 2002 is filed under Article 226 of The Constitution of India praying to issue a writ of declaration declaring that the impugned Nationalised Banks (Management and Miscellaneous Provisions) (Second Amendment) Scheme 2000, S.O.934(E) published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, in Part II - Sec. 3 (11) dated 17.10.2000 is illegal and violative of Article 14 and Article 19 of the Constitution of India.

Petition in W.P.No.42990 of 2002 is filed under Article 226 of The Constitution of India praying to issue a writ of mandamus directing the third and fourth respondent to forbear from continuing with the verification of membership strength of the officers organisations, contrary to the provisions of the Nationalised Banks (Management and Miscellaneous Provisions) (Second Amendment) Scheme 2000 published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, in Part II - Sec. 3 (11) dated 17.10.2000.
