PRAYER: This petition is preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C to direct the I Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Court under PCR Act Cases, Thanjavur, Thanjavur District to accept the surrender of the petitioners and to consider the bail application on the same day in accordance with law of their surrender in connection with Crime No.173 of 2015 on the file of the Inspector of Police, Naducavery Police Station, Thanjavur District.

ORDER

The petitioners approach this Court to direct the I Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Court under PCR Act Cases, Thanjavur, Thanjavur District to accept the surrender of the petitioners and to consider the bail application on the same day in accordance with law of their surrender in connection with Crime No.173 of 2015 on the file of the Inspector of Police, Naducavery Police Station, Thanjavur District.

2. The petitioners are alleged to have committed an offence under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 341 and 324 of IPC r/w Sec. 3(1) (r) (s), 3(2) (va) of Schedule Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Ordinance Act, 2014. It is stated by the petitioners that they are innocent.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are prepared to surrender before the lower Court to co-operate with the prosecution and their petitions for bail may be ordered to be considered on the same day.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) would oppose the said request.



5. Considering the submission of the petitioners and considering the fact and circumstances by issuing a direction to the lower Court to dispose of the petition for bail on the same day, no prejudice would be caused to the prosecution, the following direction is issued to the lower Court:-

"In the event of the petitioners surrendering before the I Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Court under PCR Act Cases, Thanjavur, Thanjavur District and their filing of petition seeking bail, the I Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Court under PCR Act Cases, Thanjavur, Thanjavur District shall dispose of the said petition for bail on the same day strictly on merits and in accordance with law."

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition stands disposed of.
