PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A2 and A3 apprehend at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under sections 24(A) (d) of the Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act r/w 272 and 420 of IPC, in Crime No.331 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

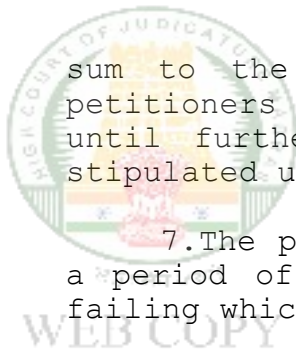
2.The case of the prosecution is that the accused persons working in the TASMAL shop had sold the materials, mixing with water.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the 1st petitioner is the Manager and the 2nd petitioner is the sales man of the TASMAL shop and they have not nothing to do with the alleged offence and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the investigation is almost completed and no previous case is pending against the petitioners.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Kumbakonam and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like



sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
