PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is the sole accused apprehends at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under sections 420, 417 and 506(i) of IPC, in Crime No.208 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.According to the de-facto complainant, the accused had borrowed Rs.12,00,000/- from him for execution of the contract work and thereafter, he only paid Rs.6,50,000/- and refused to pay the balance amount of Rs.5,50,000/-, thereby cheated the de-facto complainant.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the de-facto complainant and the petitioner are friends and the petitioner borrowed money before 2012 and the entire amount was settled by the petitioner and there is no due as on date. It is further submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the accused had borrowed money from the de-facto complainant, but failed to repay the same as per the terms.

5.Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police on 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.



7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
