PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

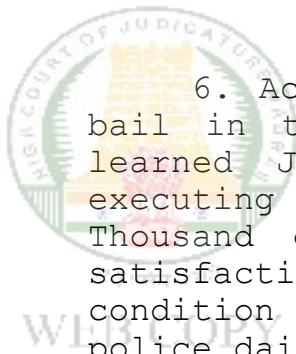
The petitioners, who are arrayed as A2 to A5, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 147, 427, 294(b) and 506(i) I.P.C in Crime No. 259 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the accused have damaged the bumper of the defacto complainant's car to the tune of Rs.2,000/-.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the occurrence is said to have taken place on 05.06.2015. But the complaint was preferred on 09.06.2015. The learned counsel further submitted that the petitioners and the defacto complainant are close relatives and due to a dispute over the Jamath election, a false complaint has been given.

4.Heard The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side).

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions.



6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, No.II, Ramanathapuram, on each of them executing a separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m for a period of one week and thereafter as and when required. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
