PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners/A1 and A2 apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294 (b), 323 and 506(i) IPC in Crime No.160 of 2015 and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.It is alleged that there was a wordy altercation between the petitioners and the defacto complainant due to which, the defacto complainant was assaulted by the petitioners.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that a false complaint has been lodged by the defacto complainant.

4. The learned Government Advocate submitted that no one sustained injury in this case.

5.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the State and also perused the entire materials available on record.

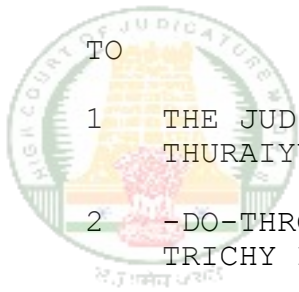
6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thuraiyur, Trichy District, and on each of them executing a separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction to the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
