PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A1 and A2, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 498(A) and 406 of I.P.C., in Crime No.27 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

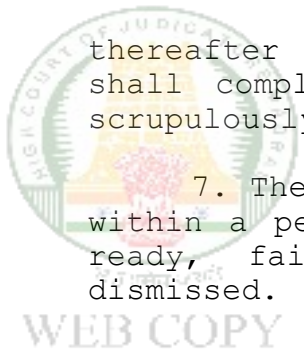
2.The case of the prosecution is that the accused have joined together and demanded more dowry and harassed her.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case and that the first petitioner had already filed H.M.O.P.No.25 of 2015 on the file of the Sub Court, Sivagangai for dissolution of marriage with the de-facto complainant and after receipt of notice, the present criminal complaint has been preferred. He further submitted that as per direction of this Court, the first petitioner had appeared before the Mediation, but however, the de-facto complainant did not turn up.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that the second petitioner is not arrayed as an accused in this case and hence, this petition is dismissed in respect of the second petitioner.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the first petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the first petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Manamadurai and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum and on the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the first petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., for a period of three weeks and



thereafter as and when required for interrogation. The first petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The first petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
