PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

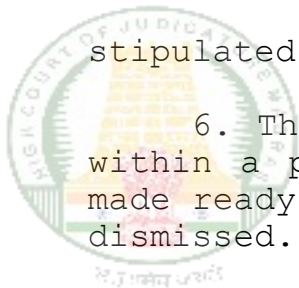
The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(i) I.P.C. in Crime No.312 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that there was wordy quarrel between the petitioner and the defacto complainant and due to which the petitioner and two others attacked the defacto complainant with wooden stick and caused injuries.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that due to previous enmity, the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that injured had already been discharged from the hospital.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Kulithalai, and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the condition



stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
