PRAYER: This petition is preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C to direct the learned I Additional District Judge (Special PCR Court), Thanjavur to consider the bail application filed by the petitioner on the same day of surrender in Crime No.266 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER

The petitioner approaches this Court to direct the learned I Additional District Judge (Special PCR Court), Thanjavur to consider the bail application filed by the petitioner on the same day of surrender in Crime No.266 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police.

2. The petitioner is alleged to have committed an offence under Section 341, 294(b), 324 and 307 of IPC and Sections 3(1)(r)(s), 3(2)(va) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act. It is stated by the petitioner that he is innocent.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is prepared to surrender before the lower Court to co-operate with the prosecution and his petition for bail may be ordered to be considered on the same day.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) would oppose the said request.

5. Considering the submission of the petitioner and considering the fact and circumstances by issuing a direction to the learned I Additional District Judge (Special PCR Court), Thanjavur to dispose of the petition for bail on the same day, no prejudice would be caused to the prosecution, the following direction is issued to the lower Court:-

"In the event of the petitioner surrendering before the learned I Additional District Judge (Special PCR Court), Thanjavur and his filing of Petition seeking bail, the learned I Additional District Judge (Special PCR Court), Thanjavur shall dispose of the said petition for bail on the same day strictly on merits and in accordance with law."



6. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition stands disposed of.
