2. The learned Government Advocate (Cr1.side) on instruction submitted that petition enquiry is pending.

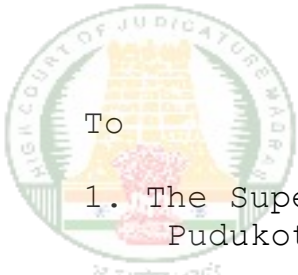
