PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

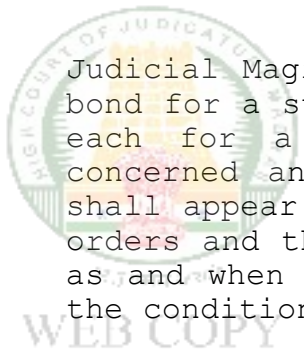
The petitioners, who are arrayed as accused in Crime No.247 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 324 and 506(ii) IPC and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2. According to the prosecution, due to family dispute, the petitioners entered into the house of the defacto complainant and the first accused attacked with stick on the head of the defacto complainant and others attacked the son of the defacto complainant and also threatened them with dire consequences.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and they are innocent persons.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the State submitted that it is a case of case and counter and the injured had already been discharged from the hospital.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned



Judicial Magistrate, Nilakottai, and on each of them executing a separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners 1, 2, 3 and 5 shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m until further orders and the fourth petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
