PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

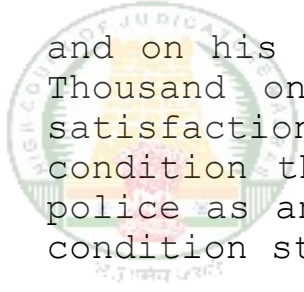
The petitioner, who is arrayed as accused No.4, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 506(i) I.P.C., r/w. Section 4 of TNPWH Act in Crime No.53 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the accused abused the de-facto complainant with filthy language and attacked her with wooden log.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and she has been falsely implicated in this case.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that totally there are four accused in this case and the accused Nos.1 to 3 were arrested and released on bail by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Arupukottai on 04.06.2015 in Crl.M.P.No.4306 of 2015.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered on bail in the event of his arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Arupukottai



and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
