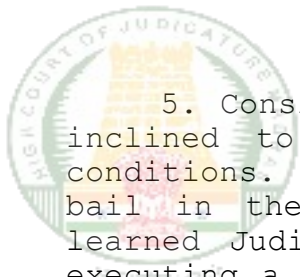
COMMON ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as accused, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 435, 506(i) and 109 of I.P.C., in Crime No.196 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2. According to the de-facto complainant, on 05.07.2015, the accused had gone to the house of the de-facto complainant and demanded money and also damaged his two wheeler to the tune of Rs.3,000/-.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that one Kannan has sustained injury in a motor vehicle accident involving the vehicle belonging to the de-facto complainant and the accused have gone to the house of the de-facto complainant to seek financial assistance and at that time, wordy quarrel arose between them and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that the petitioners have no bad antecedent.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of their arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Uthamapalayam, Theni District and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
