PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as accused in Crime No.63 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 341, 324, 323, 294(b), 506(ii) IPC and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2. According to the defacto complainant, the petitioners came to the house of the defacto complainant and abused the defacto complainant with filthy language and attacked with stick and threatened with dire consequences.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners did not involve in the offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the State submitted that it is a case of case and counter and injured had already been discharged from the hospital. He would further submit that the second petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II,Usilampatti, and on each of them executing a separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.



6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
