PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A2 apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under section 366(A) of IPC and section 4 of Protection of Children Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012, in Crime No.162 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.According to the de-facto complainant, A1 kidnapped his daughter on 05.07.2015 with the help of A2.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. The learned counsel further submitted that it is a case of love affair and the daughter of the de-facto complainant, on her own volition joined with A1 and now, the victim is secured and she is in the custody of the de-facto complainant. It is further submitted that A1 is the prime accused in this case and he was already arrested and remanded to judicial custody.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the victim was secured and she is now with the de-facto complainant.

5.Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case,

this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.



6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Mahila Court, Trichy and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate/Judge concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
