ORDER

The petitioners approach this Court seeking a direction to the III Additional District and Sessions Judge cum PCR Court, Madurai, to consider the bail application on the same day in the event of the petitioners surrender before the III Additional District and Sessions Judge cum PCR Court, Madurai, in connection with Crime No.266 of 2015 pending on the file of the respondnt police.

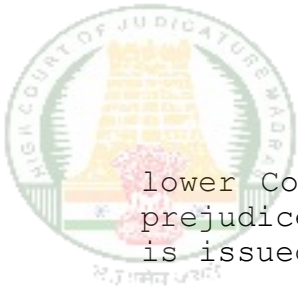
2. The petitioners are alleged to have committed an offence under Sections 294(b), 323, 324, IPC r/w Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Women Harassment Act and Section 3(1)(X) of SC/ST Act. It is stated by the petitioners that they are innocent.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are prepared to surrender before the lower Court to co-operate with the prosecution and their petitions for bail may be ordered to be considered on the same day.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) would oppose the said request.

5. Considering the submission of the petitioners and considering the fact and circumstances by issuing a direction to the



lower Court to dispose of the petition for bail on the same day, no prejudice would be caused to the prosecution, the following direction is issued to the lower Court:-
