petitioner has given a representation dated 20.04.2015 seeking police protection to put up compound wall and fencing and also for his life and family members, but, the respondent has not passed any order and therefore, the petitioner has filed this petition.

4. Resisting the same, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would submit that the respondent received the representation and the respondent advised the petitioner to approach the appropriate civil forum and he prayed for dismissal.

Considering the fact that the representation of the petitioner dated 20.04.2015 is pending before the respondents, the second and third respondents are directed to pass an order on the petitioner's representation in accordance with law within a period of 7 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
