PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as accused, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 147 and 148 of I.P.C., and Section 3 of TNPPDL Act, in Crime No.153 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 15.07.2015, the petitioners caused damage to the vehicle of the defacto complainant to the tune of Rs.10,000/-.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that the petitioners are ready to deposit Rs.1,000/- each to the credit of Crime No.153 of 2015 without prejudice to their right in the criminal case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side)would submit that the petitioners have caused damage the front glass of the car belonged to the def-cato complainant.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain condition that the petitioners shall deposit a sum of Rs.1,000/-(Rupees one Thousand only) each to the credit of Crime No.153 of 2015 before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Srivaikundam within a period of two weeks of the same, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Srivaikundam and on each of them executing a bond



for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall reside at Melur and report before the Melur Police Station daily at 10.00 a.m., until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
