The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by the Sessions Court on the condition that he should appear before the respondent police daily at 05.00 p.m until further orders and as per the order, he was complying the condition from 16.06.2015 to 21.06.2015 and thereafter, he was not permitted to sign as the concerned note book was missing and since, the respondent is not permitting the petitioner to comply with the condition, the petitioner is ready appear before the concerned Judicial Magistrate Court.
