As per the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Lalita Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P. & others* [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)], the second respondent police may conduct a preliminary enquiry which shall not extend beyond a period of seven days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In conducting the preliminary enquiry, they shall put the concerned parties upon notice and thereof, if any cognizable offence is made out, they shall duly register a case. In the event of effecting closure of the case upon conducting a petition enquiry, a copy of the



closure report shall be forwarded to the complainant.

5. The Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with the above direction.
