2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side). The learned Counsel appearing for the intervenor would vehemently argued.

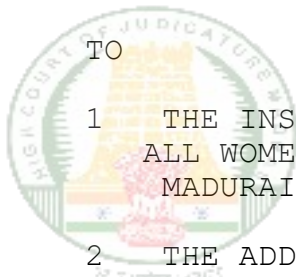
