3. As per the dictum laid down in **Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)]**, the Investigating Agency must be given seven days time to conduct enquiry and register a case, if any cognizable offence is made out.

However, in the case on hand, a perusal of the typed-set of papers would go to show that the complaint has been sent to the second respondent only on 28.07.2015 and this petition has been filed on 04.08.2015. Therefore, I am of the view that it is too premature to consider the petition at this stage. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed, as it is premature.
