PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as accused No.4, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 447, 294(b), 323, 354 and 506 (ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.295 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with other accused trespassed into the land of the de-facto complainant and attacked the de-facto complainant with dire consequences.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case and the co-accused were already arrested and released on bail by the Judicial Magistrate, Kodaikanal in Cr.M.P.No.2697 of 2015 dated 28.07.2015.

4. Heard the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side).

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of his arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Kodaikanal and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m, for a period of two weeks and thereafter as stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.



6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
