PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as A2 to A6, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 147, 341, 323 and 506(i) of I.P.C. in Crime No.98 of 2015 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

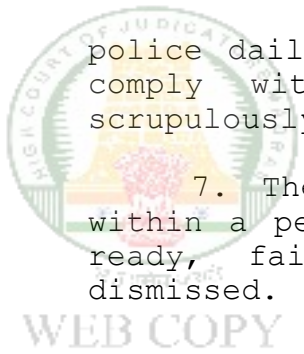
2.The case of the prosecution is that on 08.08.2015 due to previous enmity in respect of a civil dispute, the petitioners along with others trespassed into the de-facto complainant's land and attacked him.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would submit that the injured had discharged from the hospital on 10.08.2015.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the injured had already been discharged from the hospital on 10.08.2015, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Nilakkottai and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent



police daily at 10.00 a.m., until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
